INU – Istituto Nazionale di Urbanistica (The National Town Planning Institute)

The National Town Planning Institute, which was founded in 1930, is “A public law entity...of elevated culture and legally recognised technical co-ordination” (art. 1 Statute, Presidential Decree 21.11.1949). In 1997 it was legally recognised by the Ministry for the Environment as an *Environmental Protection Association* (Law 389/86) and since 1997 it has also been part of the *European Council of Town Planners*.

The INU is an **open association** of entities and private individuals which operates on a non-profit basis. With the activity of its associates, it aims at fulfilling **cultural objectives and also offers support to public administrations** by means of research activity within the various fields of town planning. It promotes **cultural events** and prints **magazines and publications**, it is also active as regards the continuous updating and renewal of town planning culture and techniques, it promotes a social culture on themes concerning the city, the territory, the environment and cultural heritage.

Founded in 1995, INU Edizioni prints and distributes the publications of the National Town Planning Institute, availing of its own sales network as well as eighty-five bookstore dealerships and agents.

The National Town Planning Institute is the founding member of the Fondazione Astengo, which is named after a great Italian town planner. It promotes, organises and manages programmes and training projects for

professionals working in the field of planning, it also houses the INU's historical archive and library.

Planum, an on-line magazine, was founded by the INU in 1999, it is actually a "portal" on town planning which aims at encouraging interaction and the exchange of views between various subjects operating throughout Europe in the field of territorial planning.

Urbanistica Italiana srl (URBIT srl) is a company that was set up by the INU in the year 2000 to manage its research, consultancy and service providing activities, with particular emphasis on territorial entities.

How to become a member of the INU

To join the INU you need to **present an application** (you can download the application form from the website at http://www.inu.it/informazioni/associarsi_inu.html) to the **President of the relevant Branch** (either according to your place of residence or your place of work), which must be signed by two active members of the Institute and accompanied by a brief curriculum vitae and the payment receipt of the subscription fee for the first year. **The regional executive Boards approve the applications** and then forward them to the national headquarters for ratification and registration.

For public Bodies who wish to join it is sufficient to send the National Branch of the Institute the deliberation from the competent organs, (you can download the application form from the website at http://www.inu.it/informazioni/associarsi_inu.html or request it from the Institute's secretariat), along with the fee for the first annual period or a copy of the receipt of payment of the same.

Active Members are normally chosen from among members who are distinguished scholars, researchers or persons who can be singled out for their professional activity, as well as their activity as members and they are nominated by the National Council of Directors, following submission, by the Branches, of a proposal and a motivated report.

All members must pay the annual subscription fee (to be paid in January).

Only members who have paid their membership fees in full are allowed to participate in regional Assemblies, the national Assembly and to present their candidature for office.

Failure to pay the membership fees will first lead to suspension in the forwarding of magazines and then cancellation from the members' roll.
